**10 Effective Ways
to Witness**

Below are ten (10) effective ways that you can make an eternal difference in the lives of those you work with.

I. Mind Your Own Spiritual Condition

Keep yourself in the Love of God, being rooted and grounded in the faith, growing in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

I have found 3 essential exercises (or disciplines) that will help you maintain and grow in the Lord. Daily prayer, daily bible reading and daily fellowship. These are the building blocks to a stable life in Christ.

II. Fully Identify with Christ in your work environment

Live a Christian life with all the moral, professional, courteous, uplifting, blameless manners that are becoming to a Christian. Some biblical examples: Joseph, Daniel, Samuel.

III. Don't shrink back when moral issues are discussed or in question.

IV. Don't go to restaurants that are borderline or beyond good moral character.

*Remember your company hired a Christian man or woman, which is much different from a person who just happens to be a Christian on Sundays.

V. Be aware of the eternal condition of those you work with.

Learn if they are saved or caught in a cult. Enemies as well as friends of the gospel of Christ will manifest.

VI. Recognize the Opportunities to encourage others to follow Christ.

As you live sympathetically with others, be aware of their situation and needs. And develop your relationship with them so that you can freely offer prayer or literature to help them through life.

Christian encouragement, friendship, and times of instruction will occur during the following times:

Mornings, coffee breaks, lunch time, end of day.

VII. Be equipped with literature.

Discipleship cannot occur apart from the scriptures. Keep either bibles, new testaments, gospels of John, tracts, etc., either at or in your desk.

Give Bibles or other literature on special occasions to fellow employees as gifts. I.e. transfers, promotions, when others leave the company for any reason.

VIII. How to handle Opposition from others:

Love your peers and managers. Do good to them who abuse you. Pray for them who spitefully use you. As much as is possible, live peaceably with all men.

Suffer wrong, if need be, when God calls you to advance a Christian principal and take it patiently. But don't let yourself be abused. Be wise as serpents, but innocent as doves.

Document your discussions with managers and peers

in times of conflict. This will help arm yourself with the facts rather than hearsay. This makes for better communication should difficulties arise for you at work.

Be pleasant, a good listener, a well mannered individual. Conduct yourself in an intelligent fashion. Avoid over reacting emotions.

IX. Ethics

Strive to maintain and promote the highest standards of proper behavior. And when you fall, admit your mistake and take measures to regain the trust and respect of others.

X. Assume the Role of a Servant / Leader

The ambassador for Christ represents heaven on earth and will have to stand before Christ and give an account for his life and every idle word spoken.

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
